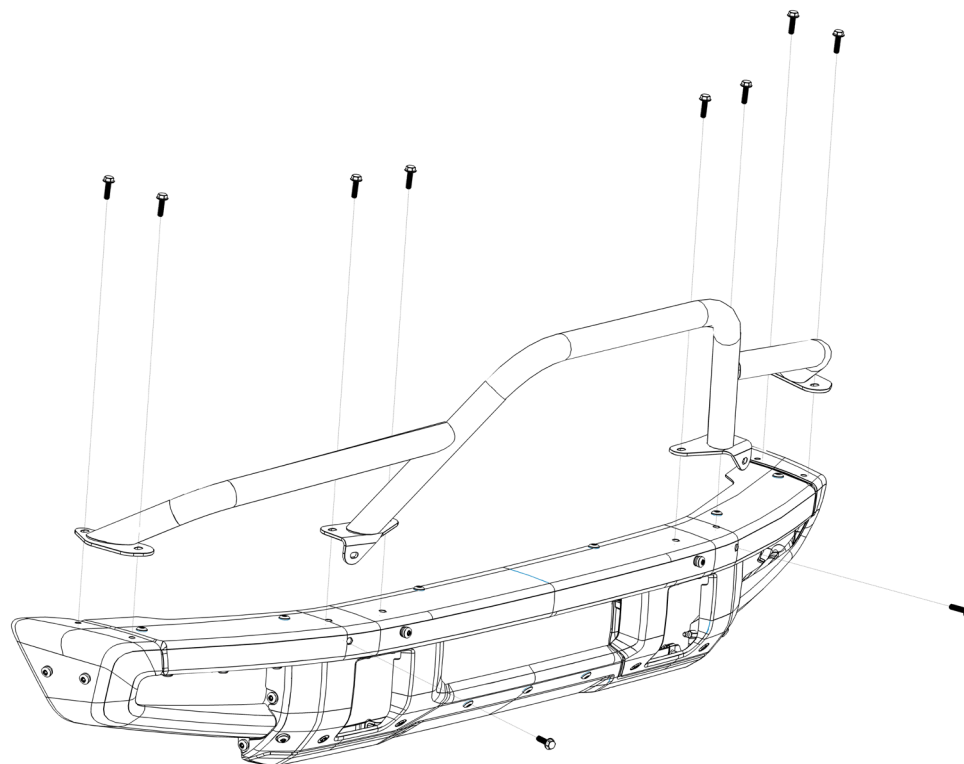


ASSEMBLY

- 1 Start by removing the ten bolts circled below.



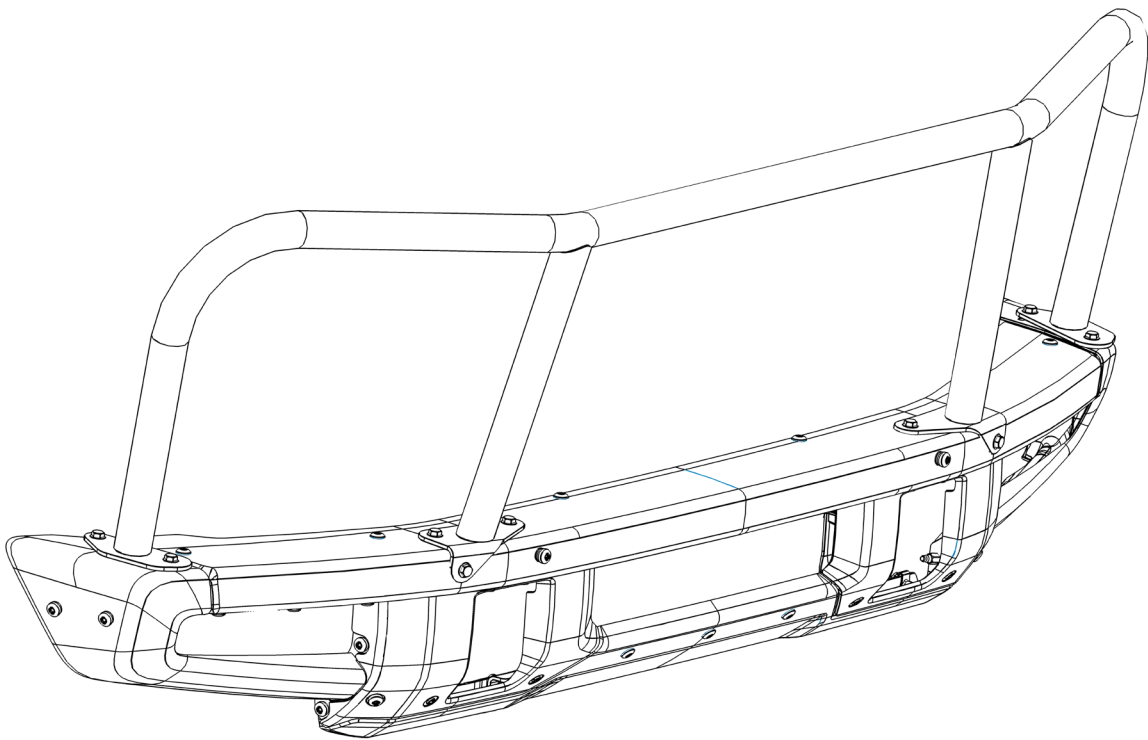
